National members have many opportunities to meet and share information with other like-minded gardeners and plantspeople at a range of national and local activities and through the website, social media and our regular publications. *The Hardy Plant*, with two issues each year, is our well-respected horticultural journal.

Our Seed Distribution Scheme lists seed from over 2000 plants donated by members from the familiar favourites to rare and unusual plants.

Our members have garden experience ranging from beginner to expert, with most of us somewhere in between.

What is a hardy plant?

As a rough guide, a hardy plant can survive a temperature of -15°C although many other factors can influence a plant's survival.
